

Appendix G - St Bartholomew, Corsham

- Please contact Buffy Gammie on 01249 712583 to discuss your floral requirements. If you are bringing flowers into the church, it would be appreciated if you could leave them there for the Sunday service.
- Our organists are Robin and Maureen Jackson, tel (01249) 713809. They are normally able to meet you after our 10am Sunday morning service, but they are available at other times too. They have a wide repertoire of the most commonly requested accompanying music, but are willing to play other suitable organ pieces on request – if they do not have the music already please be prepared to source a copy of the music for them in plenty of time for them to rehearse it.
- Our full choir is usually available for weekend weddings but we cannot usually achieve full strength for midweek ceremonies.
- Our bell ringers will usually be available for weekend services, but we cannot guarantee this for midweek. Please indicate your requirements on the booking form.
- There is a large car park outside St Bart's, which belongs to Corsham Court but which is made available to church visitors. If you are expecting more than 50 guests please let us know – extra parking may be made available by Corsham Court by opening gates onto the avenue leading down towards Pound Pill, but this is only done in good weather conditions. Please provide your guests with maps/directions to the public car parks at the south end of the High Street and the Co-op.
- If you or your guests are arriving at St. Bart's by bus or coach then please note that these must be parked elsewhere during the service, returning again to pick people up afterwards if necessary. There is limited space in the car park and large vehicles cause problems for other users.
- The church can seat over 300 adults.
- There is a toilet at the back of the church.
- We have a children's area at the rear of the church with toys and books for younger children.

Appendix H - St John the Baptist, Gastard

- Our wedding organists are usually Robin and Maureen Jackson, tel (01249) 713809. Please contact them regarding your requirements. They have a wide repertoire of the most commonly requested accompanying music, but are willing to play other suitable organ pieces on request – if they do not have the music already please be prepared to source a copy of the music for them in plenty of time for them to rehearse it.
- Our ability to have a choir at Gastard is limited by the layout of the building, but please do discuss it with us if you would like this option.
- There are no bells at Gastard.
- Cars can be parked on the road immediately outside the church.
- The church capacity is around 80 adults.
- There is a toilet (outside)
- We have a limited selection of children's toys at the back of the church.

- Our regular organist is Miss Fiona Draper, tel (01249) 448362, although we do have a number of other people who play for us at weddings when she is not available, all of whom are familiar with and fully competent on the most popular choices of wedding music. Please contact Fiona in the first instance to discuss your musical requirements.
- Our full choir is available for weekend weddings; if your wedding is midweek we will do our best to provide a choir and will confirm whether or not this is possible.
- Our bell ringers will usually be available for weekend services, but we cannot guarantee this for midweek. Please indicate your requirements on the booking form.
- The sound system at St Cyriac's is the best in our team and most suited to supporting a modern worship band as an alternative to organ music.
- Being a popular tourist destination causes a few issues for large gatherings in Lacock! Car parking in Lacock village is very limited: cars for infirm guests and those delivering the wedding party can drop people at the church gates, but will need to park elsewhere. The bridal car may loiter during the ceremony but may need to move for local residents' access. Your guests should be encouraged to park in the Red Lion car park (donations) or the National Trust car park (free to NT members) rather than parking on-street or in front of yellow 'Residents' signs. On the plus side, your service will gather lots of attention from residents and tourists alike and you can expect a large crowd of spectators and well-wishers when you emerge from the church.
- There is a toilet inside the church. We have a room upstairs with toys for babies, which acts as a self-service crèche and private baby feeding/changing area, where an audio feed of the service is relayed. We also have an area at the back of the church with books and toys for young children.
- The church holds in excess of 250 adults.

- Our full choir is available for weekend weddings; if your wedding is midweek we will do our best to provide a choir and will confirm whether or not this is possible.
- There is no sound amplification or hearing loop at St Anne's.
- There are no bells at St Anne's.
- Cars can be parked on the gravel drive behind the church or on the road immediately outside the church.
- The church holds around 100 adults.
- Unfortunately there is no toilet here and, as yet, no special provision for babies or children.

Appendix K - St Philip and St James, Neston

They have a wide repertoire of the most commonly requested accompanying music, but are willing to play other suitable organ pieces on request – if they do not have the music already please be prepared to source a copy of the music for them in plenty of time for them to rehearse it.
- We do not have a resident choir at Neston, but if you would like this option please discuss it with us.
- There is a single bell at Neston which will be rung to announce your exit from the building!
- Cars can be parked on the road immediately outside the church.
- Church capacity is around 120 adults.
- We have a toilet in the building with baby changing facilities. Younger children can be taken out into the vestibule from where supervising adults can still see and hear the service. Babies can be fed in the vestibule, or in total privacy in an upstairs room.
