NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Provision and installation of three additional memorial stone slabs on suitable sub-bases (see attached quotation from James Long (Mansons) Ltd) adjacent to the South Boundary wall of the churchyard to the west of the existing footpath and 'kissing gate'. The purpose of the memorial stones is to record the names of those whose ashes are interred nearby but the existing memorial stone slabs are now full. The stone to be used will be of similar stone type, colour and design to the existing memorial stone slabs situated immediately to the east of the existing footpath and 'kissing gate'. The location to the west of the footpath is chosen as there is no suitable space available alongside the existing stone slabs.

A letter of objection must include your name and address and state whether you live in the parish and/or your name is entered on the church electoral roll of the parish or any other basis on which you have an interest in the matter.**

### **Directions to petitioner**

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
